

Hedgehog Pencil Case

Build a simple Hedgehog shaped pencil case.

Tools:

Handsaw
Scrollsaw / Bandsaw / Coping Saw
Drill and various sized bits

Timber:

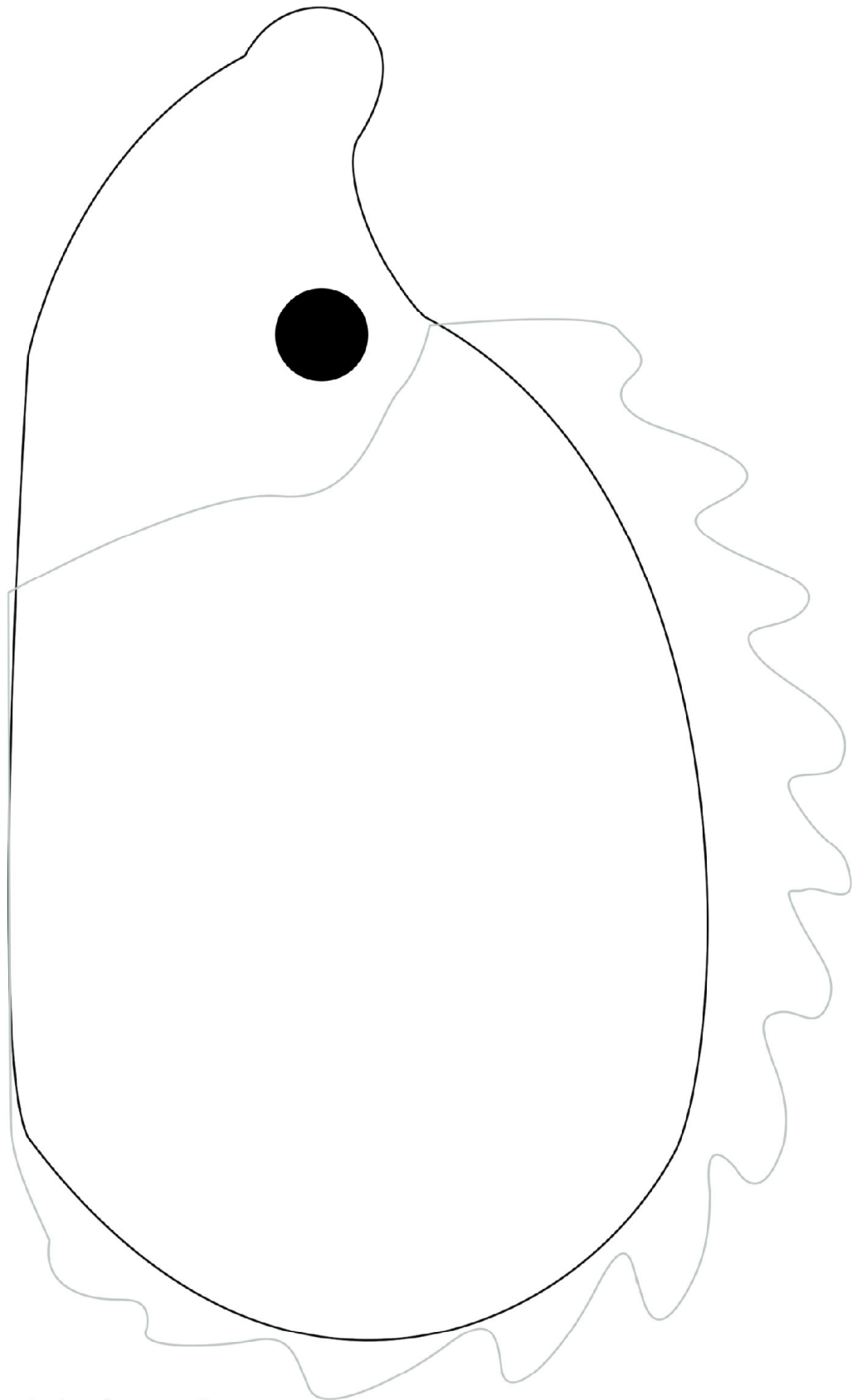
3 lengths 12mm pine, 140mm x 250mm

Other:

Glue
Paint / Lacquer



1) Make Two cutouts for the outsides, grey outline;
Make One cutout of the inside, black outline, Drill the eye out.



** I haven't marked the holes for pencils.
Depending on the size and number you plan on using,
place holes appropriately.*

2) Use a drill bit a little wider than the pencils you want the Hedgehog to hold.

Start drilling directly down then tilt the drill to create an angled hole.

Drill holes down the spine of the center body piece as well.

Practise your technique on scraps first.



** If you are using skinnier pencils you could use a Kreg jig to make the angled holes uniform.*

3) Sand all sides and glue the 3 parts together.



4) Put a finish on and fill it with pencils. Done!
